What is Summer SONdays?

Summer SONdays is not the typical vacation Bible camp. Celebrating its 16th year here at St. Matthias, this exciting two week experience involves the entire family and parish community. Each weekday from 9:00 AM-12:30 PM, children entering Pre-K 4 through grade 5 (Fall 2008) have a fun time learning about God, and the bible in creative, meaningful ways. Teens share the Good News with the children by singing and acting out biblical stories in a large group setting at the beginning and end of each day. The children then go to their smaller age groups to “break open the Word”— to relate the scripture story for the day to their everyday lives. This transformative, two-week journey also involves a parade on the last day, a family night, family Masses, entertainment by the teen Good News Players, and the famous *Summer SONdays* Show, featuring guest stars and the Stewardship Game!

Families (at least one parent) are asked to volunteer in one ministry area at Summer SONdays, such as serving as a group leader, helping with arts & crafts, sharing their hospitality for events, or in many other ways.

Good News Players interact with the children by acting out skits, singing songs, assisting group leaders, writing and producing the Summer SONdays show, and many more fun activities.
